My task was to create a Ruby code to access the functionalities of the Docker gem. During my time at RS2, I gained valuable experience in the IT industry and deepened my understanding of how Docker is utilized in modern software development.

I was part of a team of four students assisting the administration team. Our main task was supporting the IT developers team in building a system for a project focused on migrating data from physical to digital formats. This experience helped me become familiar with an office environment and enhanced my communication skills, allowing me to work more effectively within a team.

Full Stack Developer - Wyzer (July 2022 - January 2025)

Joined the development team shortly before the project's launch, initially focusing on stress-testing the APIs to determine the system's load limits. Afterward, worked within a small team responsible for maintaining the project, collaborating closely with the client to resolve bugs and implement new features based on their feedback. Contributed to both backend and frontend development using Elixir and Vue.js, building new features and APIs while fixing issues. This role strengthened team communication skills and introduced new languages and technologies.

Software Engineer - Hub88 - Yolo Group (February 2025 - Present)

Joined Hub88 as part of the team formed to build Pay.io, a payment system spanning several products offered to clients. Responsibilities include developing APIs in Elixir both to integrate with external payment providers and to expose endpoints that clients use to consume the products, collaborating with the team on database design and key backend architecture decisions, and contributing to task planning. Also reviews pull requests from fellow engineers and helps with deploying releases to staging and production. Has built a solid grasp of the

business side of the product, including how it operates and how integrations with external providers work, which has supported feature planning efforts. Since the system went live, has helped debug client-facing issues using Kibana, alongside ongoing work implementing new features and APIs across the products.
